### USC COVID-19 Requirements

With cases of COVID-19 remaining low across Los Angeles County, the university is making further changes to its pandemic mitigation strategies to align with changing guidelines from Los Angeles County and the City of Los Angeles.

Beginning Monday, April 4, the **Trojan Check will no longer be required to access campus**, and the University Park Campus perimeter will no longer be staffed by CARE Crew personnel verifying Trojan Check compliance (including checking of vaccination status).

**All students, faculty, staff, and visitors should monitor themselves for symptoms daily when accessing campus.**

- If you develop any of the symptoms listed by the [CDC](#), please stay home and arrange to have a COVID-19 test as soon as possible.
- As an extra safety precaution, we encourage (but do not require) attendees to take an at home antigen test before traveling to the workshop.

**Masks** – As of March 7, 2022, masks are no longer required indoors in most locations on USC campuses. This includes classrooms. You are welcome to still wear a mask if you choose.
